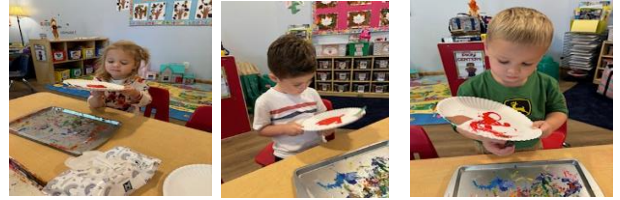

What We're Learning



News From the Nest

This week at school we learned all about apples! We talked about the different colors apples can be, what each kind of apple tastes like, where we can find (and pick) apples, and what time of year we pick apples. We also began learning about the alphabet this week, starting with the letter "A". We named items that begin with the letter, talked about the sound the letter makes, and sang a song about a silly alligator named Alice.

During circle this week, we taste tested red, green, and yellow apples. When we were finished, we made a chart of everyone's favorite color apples. The kiddos had a lot of fun doing this!

We learned two fun new songs about apples: "10 Apples on My Head" and "5 Apples in the Apple Tree".

Some of the stories we read this week included: Apples, Apples, Apples, Curious George Apple Harvest, Little Tim and the Magic Apples, Apple Trouble, and The Adventures of Abby Alligator.

During our centers this week, we filled the sensory table with soapy water, where we washed apples! We also practiced naming our shapes by placing them onto a fall tree to their matching spots.
