What We're Learning

News From the Nest

This week at school we continued talking about life cycles, moving on to frogs and chicks. During circle time this week we went over each stage of the frog and the chick. The kiddos learned each stage so quickly!

On Monday, Miss Katie came into our class and sang, dance, and blew some bubbles with us! She sang us a special song about a caterpillar that changed into a butterfly.

On Thursday, Miss Kayla came in our room to work on our gross motor skills with us as we tumbled, rolled, and danced!

Our caterpillars have all metamorphosed into their chrysalis (cocoon). The class is so excited to see the butterflies come out soon!

Some of the stories we read this week were: 5 Green and Speckled Frogs, How Long Does it Take for a Tadpole to Grow?, How Long Does it Take for an Egg to Hatch?, and Chicks!

During our fine motor craft time we painted a paper plate blue and then glued on each part of the frog life cycle, made frogs out of paper plates, made a baby chick hatching from an egg, and made a xylophone out of the letter "X"!

Next week we will continue our talk about life cycles, learning about plants and flowers.
